Dimensions: Balmy Blue: 5 ½" x 8 ¼" (score at 2" & 6 ¼"),

3" x 3", scraps

Thick Whisper White: 3 1/4" x 3 1/4" (2x)

Whisper White: scraps

Balmy Blue Glimmer Paper: scraps Designer Paper: 5 ¼"x 1 7/8" (2x)

Ribbon: 4"

1. Score the large Balmy Blue cardstock at 2" & 6 ¼". Fold along score lines and crease well. You will notice that the two front sides don't meet in the center. This is how the card should be.



2. Adhere the pieces of designer paper to the front panels of the card. Butt the edges of the cardstock to the center edges of the panels.



- 3. Die cut stitched circles from the two pieces of Thick Whisper White cardstock using the largest Stitched Shape Circle Die.
- 4. Die cut a circle from the small piece of Balmy Blue cardstock with the second largest Layering Circle Die.
- 5. Run the Balmy Blue circle through the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine with the Winter Snow Embossing Folder. Adhere to one of the Thick Whisper White stitched circles.
- 6. Cut a 4" piece of ribbon. Fold the ribbon into a loop and adhere the ends together with a Mini Glue Dot.



7. Use another Mini Glue Dot to adhere the looped ribbon to the back of the Thick Whisper White/Balmy Blue circle. Now use a piece of regular clear tape to adhere the ends of the tape down. This is so they won't catch when you slide the ornament up and down on the card front. (It's hard to see in the photo).




8. Adhere the Foam Adhesive Strip to the back of the stitched circle with the ribbon on it. Make sure it's straight.



9. Take the backing off the Foam Adhesive Strip and adhere the second Whisper White Stitched Circle to the back of the first one.



10. Slide the ornament on to the card front by lining up the Foam Adhesive Strip with the gap in the front of the card.



- 11. Die cut four different size snowflakes for the ornament from scraps of Whisper White cardstock, Balmy Blue cardstock and the Balmy Blue Glimmer Paper. Layer together with Mini Glue Dots placed in the centers of the snowflakes.
- 12. Adhere the snowflakes to the ornament with Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.



- 13. Die cut four smaller snowflakes for the second snowflake on the card from scraps of Whisper White cardstock, Balmy Blue cardstock and Balmy Blue Glimmer Paper. Layer together with Mini Glue Dots placed in the centers of the snowflakes.
- 14. Position the ornament so that the top of the ribbon loop is about even with top of the card. (See photo above)
- 15. Place a regular Stampin' Dimensional on the back of the small stack of snowflakes. Adhere to card so that some of the spokes of the snowflake overlap the edge of the ornament. This smaller snowflake will serve as a stop so that the ornament won't slide all the way through the card front.
- 16. Adhere a Blue Adhesive-Backed Gem to the center of both snowflakes.
- 17. If desired, stamp a sentiment on the inside of the card. Stamp it low enough so that it will be behind the ornament and won't show through the card front gap when the card is closed.
