

The Twelve Weeks of Christmas – Week 6 – Row of Santa Treats

 Ribbon: 22"

 Accessories: Real Red 3/8" Sheer Ribbon

 Mini Glue Dots (#103683 \$5.25)
 Multipurpose Liquid Glue

 Tools: Pine Tree Punch (#149521 \$18)
 ½" Circle Punch (retired)

1. Adhere the designer paper to the piece of Basic Black cardstock to form base of treat holder.
2. Lightly mark the center of each short side of the treat holder base. Punch half of a ½" circle on each mark. These little half circles will help hold the ribbon in place.
3. Trim off the top portion of the Clear Envelope (including the flap) so that your envelope measures 4" tall.
4. Place 5 Russell Stover mini Santa chocolates in a row along the bottom of the Clear Envelope. Fold over top of envelope and tape down
5. Adhere Clear Envelope with chocolates to the treat holder base with Mini Glue Dots.
6. Wrap the ribbon around the treat holder base and chocolates. Tie a bow on the left side of the Clear Envelope.
7. Stamp two trees on scraps of Shaded Spruce cardstock with the Shaded Spruce ink. Punch out trees with the Pine Tree Punch.
8. Place a row of liquid glue on one of the tree fronts from the top of the tree to the base of the trunk.
9. Adhere the second tree directly over the first tree. Let glue dry.
10. Adhere 6-7 Red Rhinestone Jewels to top tree.
11. When the glue has dried, bend up the sides of the top tree to make the tree 3-dimensional.
12. Adhere tree to front of treat holder with Mini Glue Dots.
13. Stamp "believe" on scrap of Whisper White cardstock with the Shaded Spruce ink.
14. Trim a rectangle around the word leaving a little extra cardstock on the right-hand side.
15. Place a Mini Glue Dot on the back right-hand side of the sentiment and adhere under tree.
