


1. Place the large piece of designer paper in front of you with the pattern that you want on the outside of your gift card holder facing down and the long sides at the top and bottom.




2. Fold the designer paper in half along the long edges.



3. Open the designer paper back up and fold each side to the center fold.



4. Open the designer paper once again. Fold each corner in to form a triangle. You want the one side to butt right up against the adjacent scored line.




5. Fold the two short sides back towards the center again.




6. Flip the designer paper over along one of the long edges so that the triangles are at the top and the bottom.




7. Fold the bottom edge up towards the center. You will make your crease at the bottom of the triangle. Make sure the sides are lined up.




8. Repeat on the other side.



9. Now tuck one side into the other. This will form your gift card holder. You have two areas where you can tuck your gift card and a note if you'd like.



10. Fold the top section down to close the gift card holder.



## **BELLY BAND:**

- 11. Wrap the strip of designer paper around your gift card holder to form the belly band. Adhere ends together with a strong adhesive. Remember not to pull the belly band too tight. You want to be able to slip it off and on easily.
- 12. Decorate the belly band however you would like. On my belly band I covered the seam with the circles so it couldn't be seen.
- 13. Punch the Mossy Meadow Circle with the retired 1 ¾" Circle Punch. You can use any size circle that you'd like. Run the circle through the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine with the Dainty Diamonds Embossing Folder to give it a little dimension.
- 14. Stamp the sentiment on scrap of Whisper White cardstock with the Real Red ink and Die cut it with the Warm Wraps Die. It die cut both the inside and the outside of the circle.
- 15. Adhere the sentiment circle directly on the Mossy Meadow Circle and pop up the center circle with a Stampin' Dimensional.
- 16. Die cut the little house from scrap of Pear Pizzazz cardstock with the star in the center of it from the Home Together Dies.
- 17. Adhere star to small circle.
- 18. Adhere the whole circle design to the belly band with Stampin' Dimensionals.
