

The 12 Weeks of Christmas – Week 12 – Star Ornament

Specialty Paper: Gold Foil Sheets (#132622 \$)

Accessories: Wonders of the Season Ribbon Combo Pack

(#153537 \$9)

Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (#144108 \$4)

Mini Glue Dots (#103683 \$5.25)

Tools: Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (#149653 \$120)

Stitched Stars Dies (#150653 \$38) 1/8" Hole Punch (non-SU/retired) Paper Trimmer (#152392 \$25)

Dimenisons: Gold Foil Sheets: 4" x 4" (2x), 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (2x)

Gold Thread: 7"

- 1. Die cut 2 stitched stars from the large pieces of Gold Foil Sheets.
- 2. Place one of the stars on the Paper Trimmer as shown in the photo below.



3. Score from the point straight down.



4. Repeat on remaining four points.



5. Repeat scoring on second large die-cut star.

6. Fold both large stars along score lines. The lines running from a point to the center should be a mountain fold and the other score lines should be valley folds.



- 7. Hold the two large stars together and punch a hole in one of the points for the gold thread.
- 8. Place Mini Stampin' Dimensionals on the inside of one of the stars on the points.



- 9. Remove the backing from the dimensionals. Place the second star over the first and adhere stars together. Make sure that you line up the holes for the gold thread.
- 10. Thread the gold thread through the holes. Tie in a knot.
- 11. To decorate you star, die cut two smaller intricate stars from the two small pieces of gold foil. Adhere to each side of the ornament with a Mini Glue Dot in the center.
