



## Envelope Flap Gatefold Card

Stamp Set: Sweet Ice Cream (#154456 \$17)

Bundle (#156244 \$31.50)

Cardstock: Blackberry Bliss (#133675 \$8.75)

Bermuda Bay (#131197 \$8.75)

Basic White (#159276 \$9.75)

Designer Paper: Ice Cream Corner (#154567 \$11.50)

Ink: Blackberry Bliss (#147092 \$7.50)

Accessories: Blackberry Bliss Striped Ribbon (#154569 \$7)

Stampin' Dimensionals (#104430 \$4)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (#152392 \$25)

Dimensions: Blackberry Bliss: 5 ½" x 4 ¼"

Bermuda Bay: 4" x 10 ½" score at 2 5/8", 7 7/8"

Basic White: 5" x 3 ¾"

Designer Paper: 6" x 6"

Ribbon: 24"

1. Score the Bermuda Bay cardstock at 2 5/8" and 7 7/8". Before creasing the score marks make sure that the two ends will butt up against each other when closed.
2. Cut the designer paper in half diagonally. You only need one triangle half for the card. Line up the long edge of the designer paper triangle with the ½" mark on the Paper Trimmer and score. Crease well.



3. With the Bermuda Bay gate fold piece closed, lay the designer paper on it so that the point of the triangle lines up with the “seam” on the front. The top of the Bermuda Bay piece should butt up against the creased score mark on the designer paper.



4. With the flap closed as in the first picture above trim the sides of the designer paper even with the Bermuda Bay cardstock.



5. Stamp “Happy Birthday” on the Basic White cardstock with the Blackberry Bliss ink.
6. Adhere the Basic White cardstock to the inside of the card.
7. Center the card over the ribbon so that when you tie the ribbon it will be on the lower portion of the designer paper. Adhere ribbon to back of card.
8. Adhere card to the piece of Blackberry Bliss cardstock.
9. Close card and tie ribbon in a bow.
10. Punch out the ice cream and the cone from the designer paper. Adhere piece to the designer paper flap of the card.



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
